SUBJECT: NOTICE TO STUDENTS

It has come to our attention that a group of individuals, including some former students, are attempting to defraud unsuspecting students. Their schemes involve:

1. Presenting **fake cheques** to clear outstanding fee balances.
2. Soliciting money from final year students who have not met graduation requirements and falsely claiming that the money will be passed on to senior managers of the University to guarantee their inclusion in the graduation list.

These fraudulent activities deliberately target vulnerable students who may be anxious about meeting graduation requirements.

All students, especially the finalists, are strongly cautioned to remain vigilant and take the necessary precautions to avoid falling victim to such scams. Please **report immediately to security** any attempts involving fake cheques or promises of influence over graduation matters.

Deans of Schools and Faculties are further requested to exercise vigilance and firmly resist any attempts to compromise the integrity of the graduation process.
