National **M**ultiplication **T**rainings (NMT) is one of the training courses under the DIES programme with the aim to strengthen DIES alumni in their roles as multipliers in the field of higher education management and to promote the sustainability of DIES trainings. It is centrally coordinated by the Center for Quality Development at the University of Potsdam in Germany.

DIES stands for Dialogue on Innovative Higher Education Strategies. It is jointly initiated by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) and the German Rectors' Conference (HRK) with funding from the Federal Ministry of Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ), Germany. DIES offers training measures in higher education management in Africa, Spanish-speaking Latin America and Southeast Asia. Current DIES trainings are focusing on faculty management, university leadership, internationalization, research management and quality assurance.

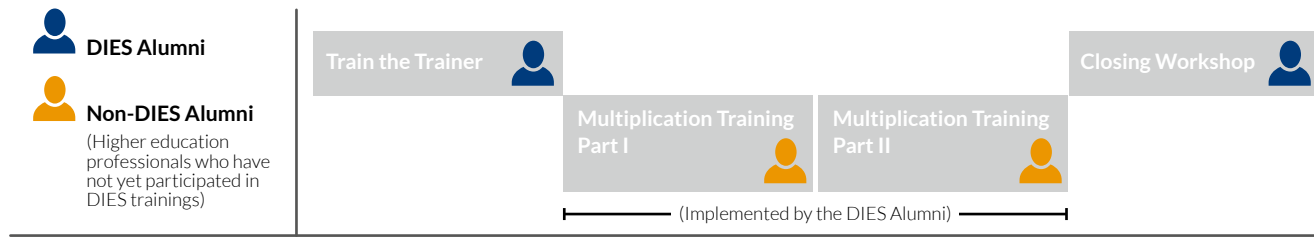

ROLE OF THE DIES ALUMNI

The NMT programme sets its focus on supporting DIES alumni to be active multipliers in higher education management. Therefore, the trainings are administered and implemented independently by them. Specifically, three or four DIES alumni compose a training committee and carry out the training accordingly. They are responsible for

- Preparing a training proposal

- Evaluating the training
- Mentoring the participants
