## RE: REVIEW OF COVID-19 CONTAINMENT MEASURES



The national government has revised the dusk to dawn curfew in 13 counties in Nyanza, Western and Rift valley. Beginning **Friday 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2021**, the curfew hours will be from **7.00pm to 4.00am**. The Ministry of Health says the move has been arrived at to reduce the Covid-19 positivity rate in the region.

The counties affected by the new curfew hours include: Busia, Vihiga, Kisii, Nyamira, Kakamega, **Bungoma**, Kericho, Bomet, Trans-Nzoia, Kisumu, Siaya, Homabay and Migori. All these counties have been declared as covid-19 hot spot zones. Movement in the hot spot zone and the rest of the country, except for essential and emergency services is strongly discouraged.

Students like other residents are required to be indoors **by 7.00pm**. You are also reminded that sporting, recreational activities as well as all public gatherings and in person meetings including house parties and night vigils are prohibited. Places of worship will also shut their doors for physical worship for a period of **30 days** from the date of the announcement. Students are advised to comply with these raft of measures to avoid confrontation with the law enforcement agencies.
