SUBJECT: COMMUNICATION ON OUTBREAK OF CHOLERA IN THE COUNTRY

The Ministry of Health issued an alert on confirmation of a cholera outbreak in multiple counties. Response activities have been set up in the affected counties and measures to contain the outbreak are ongoing.

Cholera is transmitted through consumption of contaminated water and food. Due to the ongoing drought situation and water shortage the Ministry of Health has put all counties on high alert for possible cholera outbreaks.

You are therefore advised as follows;

1. Drink treated/boiled water all the time.
2. Consume well cooked food from clean premises.
3. Clean raw fruits and vegetables with clean water before consumption.
4. Maintain hand hygiene.
5. Seek treatment promptly on developing a diarrheal illness.
