 - Supervising academic and other staff of the Faculty/School; ix.
 - Making recommendations with respect to discipline, probation, advancement, and Χ. promotion of academic staff within the Faculty/School;
 - Promoting proficiency in teaching and learning and advance the Faculty/School activities in research; innovation; collaboration; community xi. and extension services; and

Requirements

To be eligible for appointment as a Dean, applicants shall have the following minimum qualifications:

- Must have a PhD or equivalent Doctorate Degree from an accredited and recognized i. University in the relevant field;
- Must be either a Professor, Associate Professor or Senior Lecturer on permanent and ii. pensionable terms or on contract;
- Senior Lecturers must have served for at least three (3) years as Chairpersons of Department iii. or its equivalent: iv.
- Should be knowledgeable in KIBU ISO Procedures;
- Should be knowledgeable in ICT; V.
- Should be knowledgeable in Management, Budgeting and Public Procurement Procedures; vi. vii.
- Must meet Chapter Six of the Constitution of Kenya requirements on integrity issues; and
- Demonstrated merit and ability as reflected in work performance and results. viii.

Terms of Office

In accordance with Kibabii University Charter and Statutes of the University, the Dean shall hold office for a period of three (3) years with the possibility of renewal for a further term of three (3) years.
