**Subject: Conduct During Special/Supplementary Examinations of 2025/2026 Academic Year**

The above subject matters refers:

The Special/Supplementary for 2025/2026 academic year Examinations is scheduled to commence on **Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2026 to Friday 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2026.**

This is to remind you of Section **43.2**, **43.4**.and **Section 43.5** of the Students Handbook about Assessment Requirements and Admission and Conduct in Examinations.

The Sections stipulate the following among others:

- a) Sec.43.2(p). A student will not be allowed into an examination room if he/she has not completed payment of semester fees to the University.
- b) **Sec. 43.5 (h)**. Devices with Internet connection shall not be permitted in the examination venue.
- c) **Sec. 43.5 (i)**. Bringing unauthorized material and the use or attempted use of the same in an examination constitutes cheating and shall result in disciplinary action being taken against a candidate.
- d) **Sec. 43.5 (j)**. Candidates are not permitted to wear attire that compromises examination integrity, except where exemption applies for religious and/or health reasons.

All students are advised to strictly adhere to the Examination Rules and Regulations. Further, **NOTE** that a breach of any regulation amounts to Examination Misconduct.

Students are reminded that the University operates on a **Zero Fee Balance Policy**.
